2nd World Open Educational Resources (OER) Congress: OER for Inclusive and Equitable Quality Education: From Commitment to Action

The 2nd World Open Educational Resources (OER) Congress is scheduled to be held in Ljubljana, Slovenia, on 18–20 September 2017, co-organized by UNESCO and the Government of Slovenia. This event will mark five years since the World OER Congress was held in Paris in June 2012.

The Congress will follow the theme »OER for Inclusive and Equitable Quality Education: From Commitment to Action«, reflecting a strong focus on the role of OER in achieving <u>Sustainable</u> Development Goal 4.

Many ICDE members, ICDE OER Chairs in addition to the ICDE Secretary General and Senior Adviser will be in attendance and available for networking opportunities.

Presentations now available from the UNESCO IITE co-organised the Global Expert Meeting "Multilingualism in Cyberspace for Inclusive Sustainable Development"

The first-ever international forum to address the importance of multilingualism and linguistic diversity in the implementation of the sustainable development goals was successfully hosted in Khanty-Mansiysk, Russian Federation, from 5 to 9 June 2017, in the framework of the IX annual International IT Forum.

The Global Meeting was building upon the result of the debates on language preservation and the development of linguistic and cultural diversity in cyberspace organized at global, regional and national levels. Thus, nine major international events were held from 2008 to 2016, including five within the framework of the UNESCO Information for All Programme, which were focusing on the cultural, social and ethical aspects of research and development in the sphere of linguistic diversity in cyberspace and using ICT for effective language preservation.
